

RE: LUFA Communiqué – Negotiation Bulletin #2



June 17, 2022

Dear Colleagues:

The LUFA bargaining team has been informed that the Administration is still unprepared to put forward any monetary proposal and review our monetary and pension proposals.

In addition to the bargaining session on June 6, the session scheduled for June 17 has been canceled. Further, the session on **June 21** is now only tentative.

We are concerned about our employer not being ready on dates they helped schedule.

An update on their expected timetable for monetary proposals was requested this past Monday, but we have yet to receive a response.

Moreover, after only two bargaining sessions, the Administration is requesting we consider mediation. Ordinarily, the Administration and the Association prepare their positions and attempt to resolve issues collegially without the use of a third party. We see this as a very premature request given that no monetary proposal has been put forward and as such, we don't know yet if mediation may be required.
