

## LUFA Communiqué – Negotiation Bulletin #1



June 7, 2022

Dear Colleagues:

Last week the LUFA and employer bargaining teams met for two days.

The first day was devoted to the presentation of proposals. LUFA tabled a set of fifteen proposals based on the membership survey.

The second day saw the teams respond to each other's proposals.

Some trivial progress was made on proposals related to current collective agreement language.

We were frustrated that the Administration did not come prepared to discuss monetary proposals. There should have been nothing surprising about our pension proposal. Since they were unwilling to discuss monetary proposals until later in the month, we saw no fruitful purpose to meeting again on June 6, and thus that session was cancelled.

The two teams plan to meet again **on June 17 and 21, 2022**. We will update then on any further progress.
